RE: Coroner's Investigation into death of Mammoth resident

The Mono County Sheriff's Department is investigating the death of a Crowley Lake resident. On Tuesday, April 6th, at approximately 8:30 am, Long Valley Fire Department was dispatched to 396 Juniper Drive regarding a possible deceased female that was found on the floor, unresponsive, by her family members. Mono County Sheriff's Department Coroner's arrived on scene and declared the decedent deceased. The decedent is 38-year-old Cary Shibley. The cause of death is still pending further investigation.

The law requires that arrest information be made available to the public. This publication may contain suspect information about individuals booked by the Mono County Sheriff's Department recently. Names of juveniles (under 18-years-old) are not public. Suspect information and ongoing investigation details are also withheld. Since most cases have yet to be adjudicated, all charges should be considered allegations.
