Other lakes in the higher elevations may be safe for ice fishing; however, because of the rapidly changing conditions, we do not encourage people going out on the ice. Anytime you are exploring our beautiful county make sure someone knows where you are headed and be prepared for rain, snow, freezing temperatures or blue bird weather. Enjoy yourself and good luck on catching the big one.
