Subject: Current Mono City Incident

At approximately 2:00pm, Mono County Sheriff's Deputies responded to the report of a woman that appears to have broken into a residence in Mono City where she has secluded herself in the residence. Mono County Sheriff's Deputies are attempting to contact the woman and get her out of the residence safely. She is believed to be armed.

A Code Red alert was issued to citizens of the Mono City area advising them to please stay in their homes as the incident continues. The Sheriff's Department will issue another Code Red alert when the incident is under resolve.

This is all the information that is being released at this time.

The law requires that arrest information be made available to the public. This publication may contain suspect information about individuals booked by the Mono County Sheriff's Department recently. Names of juveniles (under 18-years-old) are not public. Suspect information and ongoing investigation details are also withheld. Since most cases have yet to be adjudicated, all charges should be considered allegations.
