RE: Coroner's Investigation concludes into the death of a Mammoth Lakes resident

The Mono County Sheriff's Department concluded an investigation into the death of a Mammoth Lakes resident that occurred in August.

On Wednesday, August 10, 2011, at approximately 1:30 am, a Mono County Sheriff's Department Deputy was dispatched to a residence in Old Mammoth to assist Mono County Paramedics, Mammoth Lakes Fire Department, and Mammoth Lakes Police Department for a female found unresponsive with no pulse and not breathing. When the Mono County Sheriff's Department Deputy arrived on scene, Mono County Paramedics and Mammoth Lakes Police Department officers were attempting life saving methods but were unsuccessful. Lisa Marie Longo, age 34, of Mammoth Lakes, was pronounced deceased. Final autopsy and toxicology reports deem Ms. Longo's death as an accidental death caused by asphyxiation due to aspiration of her stomach contents.

The law requires that arrest information be made available to the public. This publication may contain suspect information about individuals booked by the Mono County Sheriff's Department recently. Names of juveniles (under 18-years-old) are not public. Suspect
