Arrests In Mammoth Lakes For Narcotics

On 7/23/2009 at approximately 0710 A.M., MONET agents, members of the Mono County Sheriff's Department, and the Mammoth Lakes Police Department served a search warrant at Aspen Village, 1700 Old Mammoth Road for narcotics. Agents recovered concentrated cannabis, marijuana, peyote, and associated paraphernalia. In addition, several items of stolen property were recovered solving several recent automobile burglaries.

Christian Jose Toledo, 18 year old male resident of Mammoth Lakes, was arrested for two counts of sales for marijuana. Toledo was also charged with possession of peyote and possession of stolen property.

Jaime Marie Ramirez, 30 year old female resident of Mammoth Lakes, was arrested for possession of concentrated cannabis and possession of stolen property.

Ramiro Magana, 22 year old male resident of Benton, was arrested for possession of less than an ounce of marijuana, obstructing and delaying an officer during his investigation. Magana was found to be in violation of parole.

One additional, 16 year old male was arrested for obstructing and delaying an officer while performing his duties and in possession of stolen property.

All adults were transported to the Mono County Jail. The male juvenile was transported to Mono County Probation.

The law requires that arrest information be made available to the public. This publication may contain suspect information about individuals booked by the Mono County Sheriff's Department recently. Names of juveniles (under 18-years-old) are not public. Suspect information and ongoing investigation details are also withheld. Since most cases have yet to be adjudicated, all charges should be considered allegations.
