### **Citizens Information Leads to Narcotics Arrest**

A Mono County Deputy received information from a concerned citizen that a person by the name of "Juan" that was living and working at Mono Village in the Twin Lakes area was involved in the use of methamphetamine. On June 1, 2009 the Deputy conducted an investigation and located "Juan", he was positively identified as Mr. Juan Jose Pina Davila age 42 of Bridgeport.

During the contact with Mr. Davila the Deputy noticed he was displaying various signs of narcotics intoxication. Mr. Davila admitted using methamphetamine and told the Deputy he had purchased it in Yerington, Nevada several weeks ago.

During further investigation the Deputy located a small bindle of methamphetamine in the pocket of Mr. Davila's pants and also found several more bindles in the arm rest of a couch in the apartment after Mr. Davila told him where he usually hides his narcotics.

Mr. Davila was transported to Bridgeport Sheriff Station and booked for possession of controlled substance for sales and being under the influence of a controlled substance.
