DUI Arrest In Walker

On September 12, 2009 at approximately 7:10 a.m. a Mono County Deputy Sheriff observed a vehicle in the Walker area travelling on Larson Lane. The vehicle in question did not have a rear license plate and was driven by a Mr. Trevor William Redrobe age 26 a resident of Coleville.

During the subsequent traffic stop and investigation, the Deputy observed that Mr. Redrobe was displaying symptoms of being under the influence of narcotics. During questioning, Mr. Redrobe admitted that he was on probation and had also smoked some methamphetamine earlier that morning.

Mr. Redrobe was placed under arrest and transported to the Bridgeport Sheriff Station. He is facing charges of driving under the influence of a controlled substance and being under the influence of a controlled substance.

The law requires that arrest information be made available to the public. This publication may contain suspect information about individuals booked by the Mono County Sheriff's Department recently. Names of juveniles (under 18-years-old) are not public. Suspect information and ongoing investigation details are also withheld. Since most cases have yet to be adjudicated, all charges should be considered allegations.
