Mammoth Resident Asks For Help:

On the evening of October 28, 2009 Mono County Jail Staff was contacted by Mr. David Shelton, a resident of Mammoth Lakes. Mr. Shelton said that he was en-route back home and inadvertently hit a deer on Highway 395 just north of Bridgeport. Mr. Shelton stated that he determined that the accident had caused a fuel line on his vehicle to rupture, thus causing him to nearly run out of gas.

Mr. Shelton was able to repair the broken section of fuel line, but did not have enough fuel to get back to Mammoth. For an unknown reason both his debit cards would not work, neither he nor the Shell station attendant could remedy the problem. Mr. Shelton not having any cash on him, asked for help from the Sheriff's Department. Due to the situation, Mr. Shelton was issued a gas voucher so he could safely return to his residence.

The law requires that arrest information be made available to the public. This publication may contain suspect information about individuals booked by the Mono County Sheriff's Department recently. Names of juveniles (under 18-years-old) are not public. Suspect information and ongoing investigation details are also withheld. Since most cases have yet to be adjudicated, all charges should be considered allegations.
