### **Several Campground Thefts At Convict Lake**

On Thursday June 11, 2009 a Mono County Deputy responded to the Convict Lake Campground regarding several thefts from local campers. He contacted four different groups of campers who stated that they were the victims of various thefts from either their campsite or from inside their vehicles.

During the investigation it was determined that the suspect(s) committed the thefts between approximately 11:00 pm on the previous evening and 7:00 am on June 11. The items taken were numerous fishing rods and reels which were located in the campsite; cash from wallets left inside their unlocked vehicles; and also a Honda EU2000 generator which was chained to a trailer.

Some neighboring campers heard noises at approximately 3:30am during the evening of the thefts and other campers observed a green and tan suburban with 4 Hispanic males in it on the day prior to the thefts but it is unclear if this vehicle is related to the thefts.
