### **TRAFFIC STOP LEADS TO TWO ARRESTS**

On November 15, 2009 at approximately 6:54 PM, a Deputy conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for illegal window tinting. The occupants were contacted and identified as Mr. Trevor Redrobe age 26 and Mr. David Salmond age 42 both residents of Coleville Ca., and a third occupant in the vehicle was also a resident of Coleville.

During the investigation and subsequent vehicle search, the Deputy discovered a large plastic grocery type baggie hidden in the center console which contained numerous prescription medication pills. There was also an empty prescription bottle with a name other than any of the vehicle occupants, but it was of a local Mono County resident.

After having been given his Miranda Rights, Mr. Salmond stated he sells various medications pills to others and that he stole the pills from an employer of his, when he was doing work at the employer's personal residence.

Both men were arrested and transported to and booked at the El Dorado County Jail due to the Mono County Jail still being closed at the time. They will face various charges such as possession, sales and transportation of a controlled substance, petty theft and probation violation. The third occupant of the vehicle was deemed not being involved in the illegal activity and was released on scene.

*The law requires that arrest information be made available to the public. This publication may contain suspect information about individuals booked by the Mono County Sheriff's Department recently. Names of juveniles (under 18-years-old) are not public. Suspect information and ongoing investigation details are also withheld. Since most cases have yet to be adjudicated, all charges should be considered allegations.
