Recommendation

Have the City of Bishop complete and return the forms necessary to initiate the grant. Form an ad-hoc committee to work on organizational structure, formation of advisory council and possible grant-related activity for discussion at the February 2017 ESCOG meeting.

Discussion

On October 27, 2016, the California Public Utilities Commission adopted Resolution T-17537 which approved grant funding for the California Advanced Services Fund Consortia Account, including the \$105,216 funding requested for the Inyo-Mono Broadband Consortium.

While there is a significant amount of conversation which needs to happen surrounding the organizational structure of the Consortium (including forming the IMBC Board of Directors, IMBC Advisory Council, and IMBC Provider Council), before any substantive work can begin, two practical matters need to be addressed:

- Completion of the Grant Fund Request and Consent Form
- 2. Completion of a Payee Data Record

Both of the above-mentioned items are fiscally related, and therefore are best completed by the City of Bishop – our Fiscal Agent.

This is a somewhat time-sensitive item that was originally request to be completed by November 18th, 2016. At my request, we were given an extension to the end of December.

At future ESCOG meetings it will be necessary to deal with the formation of the Consortium and establishment of a meeting schedule and other practical items.
