






Total Positive Cases for Mono County Residents (last 30 d...







TOTAL POSITIVE CASES: 1947 (30-DAY INCREASE: 14.1%) / CASE RATE/100,000: 177.0

- 67.9% Fully Vaccinated
- 6.8% Partially Vaccinated
- Latino Population: 67.7% Fully Vaccinated
- White Population: 64.9% Fully Vaccinated
- Multi-Race Population: 71.5% Fully
 Vaccinated
- Native American Population: 56.1% Fully
 Vaccinated
- Asian American Population: 74.3 Fully
 Vaccinated

BOOSTER DATA

 3261+ COVID-19 third doses have been administered to Mono County Residents.

BOOSTER ELIGIBILITY

- Boosters for 16–17-year-old individuals
 was approved by the FDA on 12/09/2021
- Full approval for Boosters for 12–15-yearold individuals approved by FDA 01/04/2022

HOSPITAL STATUS

- Two current COVID-19 related hospitalizations
- First pediatric COVID-19 transfer
- Difficulty transferring patients
- Seeing many ski related injuries and multiple
 COVID-19 cases daily
- Staffing shortage
- Status = Green.

NEW ISOLATION AND QUARANTINE GUIDANCE

If You Test Positive for COVID-19 (Isolate)

- Everyone, regardless of vaccination status:
 - Stay home for 5 days.
 - If you have no symptoms or your symptoms are resolving after 5 days, you can leave your house.
 - Continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days.
- If you have a fever, continue to stay home until your fever resolves.

NEW ISOLATION AND QUARANTINE GUIDANCE

If You Were Exposed to COVID-19 (Quarantine)

- If you...
 - Have been boosted

OR

Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last 6 months

OR

Completed the primary series of J&J vaccine within the last 2 months

- Wear a mask around others for 10 days.
- Test on day 5, if possible.
- If you develop symptoms get a test and stay home.

OMICRON SURGE B.1.1.259 LINEAGE

- US 7-day average of new cases: over 400,000
- People hospitalized: 82,898
- People in ICU: 17,562
- Pediatric hospitalizations up 66% in a week
- Deaths remain low
