Info: Under general supervision, the COVID Screener performs a variety of duties related to the response and recovery activities due to Covid-19. Employees at this level are expected to be fully qualified and able to perform difficult and responsible office support work within the framework of established work methods and procedures and to use independent judgment in selecting and applying specific references, procedures, sequences, and alternatives to different work situations.

This position is distinguished from the COVID Screener in performing administrative level duties specific to Covid-19 response and recovery activities.

- Greet and screen clients at the County's Civic Center.
- Receives and responds to COVID-19 related phone calls, voice mail messages, and emails.
- Prepare and distribute daily and weekly reports.
- Prepares, updates, and maintains computerized spreadsheets and databases.

- Performs a variety of administrative and clerical duties.
- Record keeping and filing.
- Communicate effectively orally and in writing.
- Interpret and analyze data.

COVID-19 BOOSTER SHOTS

Boosters are now available for fully vaccinated people age 5 and older!

Booster recommendations depend on your age, the vaccine you first received, and time since last dose. Visit the CDC website to determine your eligibility: www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019ncov/vaccines/booster-shot.html

Second boosters are recommended for adults ages 50+, and some people ages 12+ who are immunocompromised, at least four months after their first booster.



FREE AT-HOME COVID TESTS

Every home in the U.S. is eligible to order a third round of free at-home COVID-19 tests.

The tests are completely free. Orders will usually ship in 7-12 days. Order your tests now so you have them when you need them.

WORK INNOVATION AND OPPORTUNITY ACT Updated Reimbursement of 50% of Wages to Employers

Are you an employer looking for help? The specific technical skills you need may be hard to find. The Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) On-the-Job Training Program helps you train the right workers to meet your requirements.

This program assists employers with the costs of hiring and training new and advancing employees by offering financial reimbursement of up to 50% of the employee's wages during the training period.
